### **GENERAL DRESS and HYGIENE CODE**

In the spirit of recognizing our human dignity, self-respect, and respect for others and for Christ, we ask campers, volunteers, and staff to adhere to this dress code. In general, please do your best to use good judgement. We trust you! It is summer and very hot, and we will be indoors mostly.

- 1. Please do not wear hats indoors.
- 2. T-shirts may be untucked, but they should be neatly worn.
- 3. Garments should display only appropriate graphics.
- 4. Sandals are permitted since it is summer.
- 5. No underwear should be visible anywhere.
- 6. Shorts, pants, and skirts should be waist level.
- 7. Shorts and skirts should be 2 inches above the knee or longer.
- 8. Hairstyles should be neat and clean.
- 9. Please wear plenty of deodorant!
- 10. Excessive jewelry is discouraged.
- 11. Shirts must have sleeves. Tank tops are not allowed.
- 12. Leggings or tights may be worn under pants, shorts, or skirts not as outer garments.
